



## **Sweetgrass Baskets of South Carolina**



Rooted in centuries of tradition, South Carolina's sweetgrass baskets are one of the oldest West African art forms in the United States. Originally brought to the Lowcountry by enslaved Africans, these baskets were first used for rice cultivation and later evolved into treasured works of art.

Crafted by hand using natural materials like sweetgrass, bulrush, palmetto, and pine needles, each basket is meticulously coiled and stitched without the use of machines. The process can take hours or even days, depending on the complexity and size.


Today, sweetgrass baskets are highly valued both as functional items and cultural heirlooms. Prices vary based on size and intricacy, ranging from around \$30 for small pieces to \$500 or more for large, elaborate designs.
